

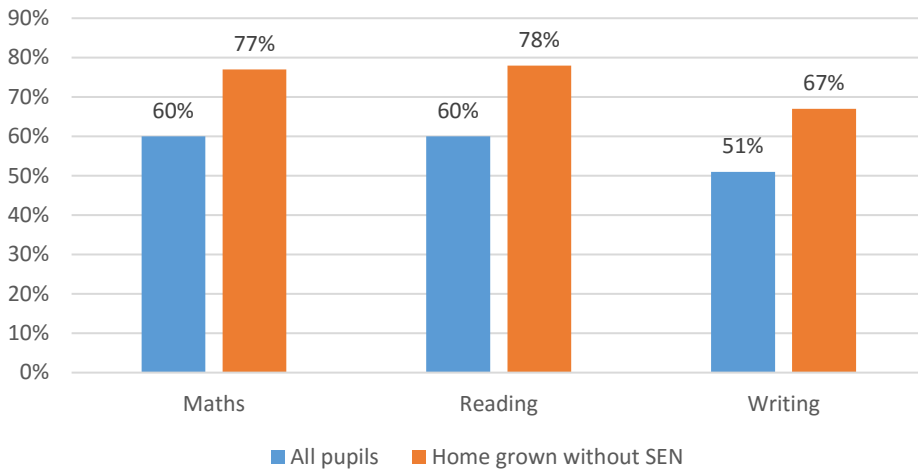
# Key Stage 1 results at Epsom Primary and Nursery school

KS1 results are not typical of our previous rising trend due to:

- A high percentage of this cohort having additional needs therefore often lower starting points.
- Mid-year mobility, which impacts negatively on the progress that can be achieved in a shorter space of time..

The table below shows our overall KS1 data compared with our non-SEND children who began their learning journey with us in Early years.

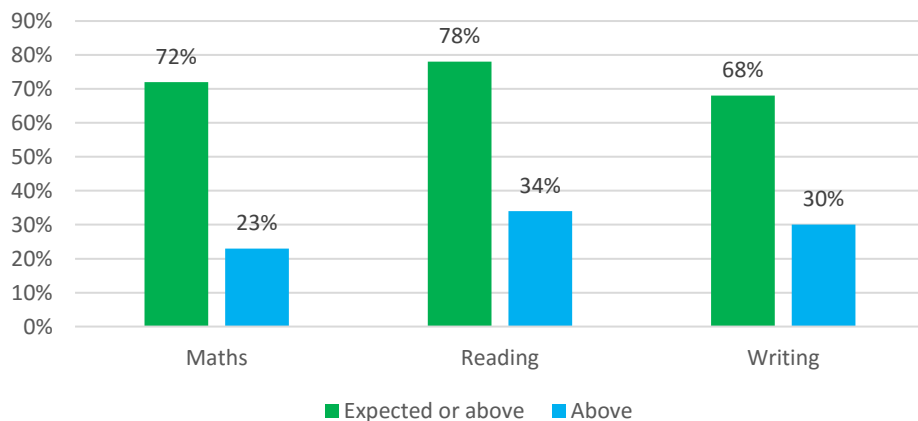
### KS1 Data - comparative

- ✓ Results for our non-SEND home-grown children are strongest in Reading and Maths.

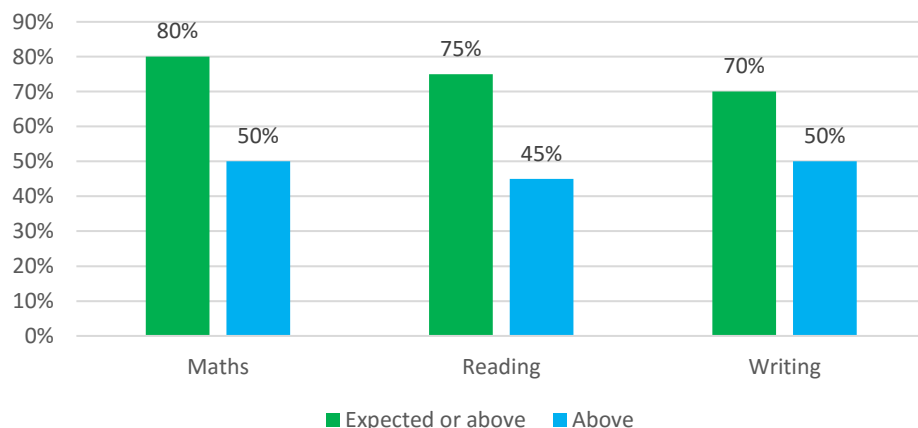
### Progress for all children in KS1



### Progress Summary for all pupils in KS1

- ✓ The greatest progress for our pupils is shown in Reading.
- ✓ More pupils make accelerated progress in reading, closely followed by writing.

### Progress for SEND children in KS1



### Progress Summary for SEND children in KS1

- ✓ Our SEND pupils show the greatest progress in Maths, closely followed by reading.
- ✓ A higher proportion of our SEND children have made accelerated progress in all subjects when compared to their peers in a drive to maximise outcomes for all.
